**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, the Court is implementing a Debtor Electronic Bankruptcy Noticing program (known as “DeBN”) pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9036 whereby Debtors can elect to receive notices and orders issued by the Court and served through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center (“BNC”) via electronic mail (e-mail);


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT**, upon receipt of a Debtor’s election to participate in the DeBN program, the Clerk of Court shall send notices and orders that would otherwise be mailed to the Debtor through the BNC via e-mail. The Clerk shall continue to send such notices electronically until the Debtor’s participation in the DeBN program terminates in accordance with the terms of the DeBN program.


